January Twilight Trip on the SPITFIRE

This is our first trip of the year. We always have a good time and we always catch fish when we go out on this boat. The load (number of fishermen) is a low 20 so there will be plenty of room to move around. This trip should provide a delightful evening of fun fishing.

Booking Requirements;

A 50% deposit is required to hold a spot on all club trips that are over \$100.00. On trips costing \$100.00 or less the full trip price must be paid to reserve a spot. The balance on all trips over \$100.00 must be paid 30 days before the trip goes. Non-members may book spots, however, they can be "bumped" by a paying member up to 30 days before the scheduled trip date, after that their spot is secure. Non-members pay \$15 per day over the prices shown except on trips on the Spitfire.

2012 Trip Schedule

The trip schedule that follows is a preliminary view of our 2012 trips. Additional trips may be added if there is opportunity and interest in doing so. The club has a history with all the boats scheduled so far and our experience has been good with these boats/skippers. Trip 5 the July Pacific Dawn trip may be out of Ventura where the boat spends the winter or San Diego, which ever area offers the best opportunity to catch quality fish.

Skipper Pat Cavanaugh may make this decision based on the fishing results at the time, if the Albacore are showing in good numbers for overnight trips it will be San Diego otherwise it will be Ventura.
